4. To add any extra children, please click "New Participant" on the left sidebar and fill in information.

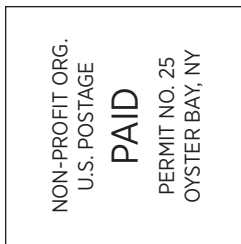
**NOTE:** Group assignments are based on age at time of camp session

## Registration

1. Select the child you wish to register. *Each child must be registered separately.*
2. Select "Registration" and then "Register for New Session"
3. Select the session(s) you wish to register your child for and then click continue.
4. Follow prompts to pay. *You do NOT need to sign up for the Protection Plan.*
5. After you have registered ALL your child(ren), please fill out the Health Profile for each child.

**NOTE:** You do NOT need to fill out the Health Profile immediately after registering your child. If you are registering multiple children, please register ALL children before filling out the Health Profile.
